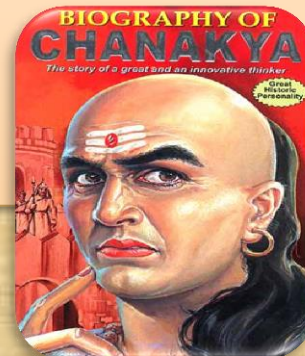

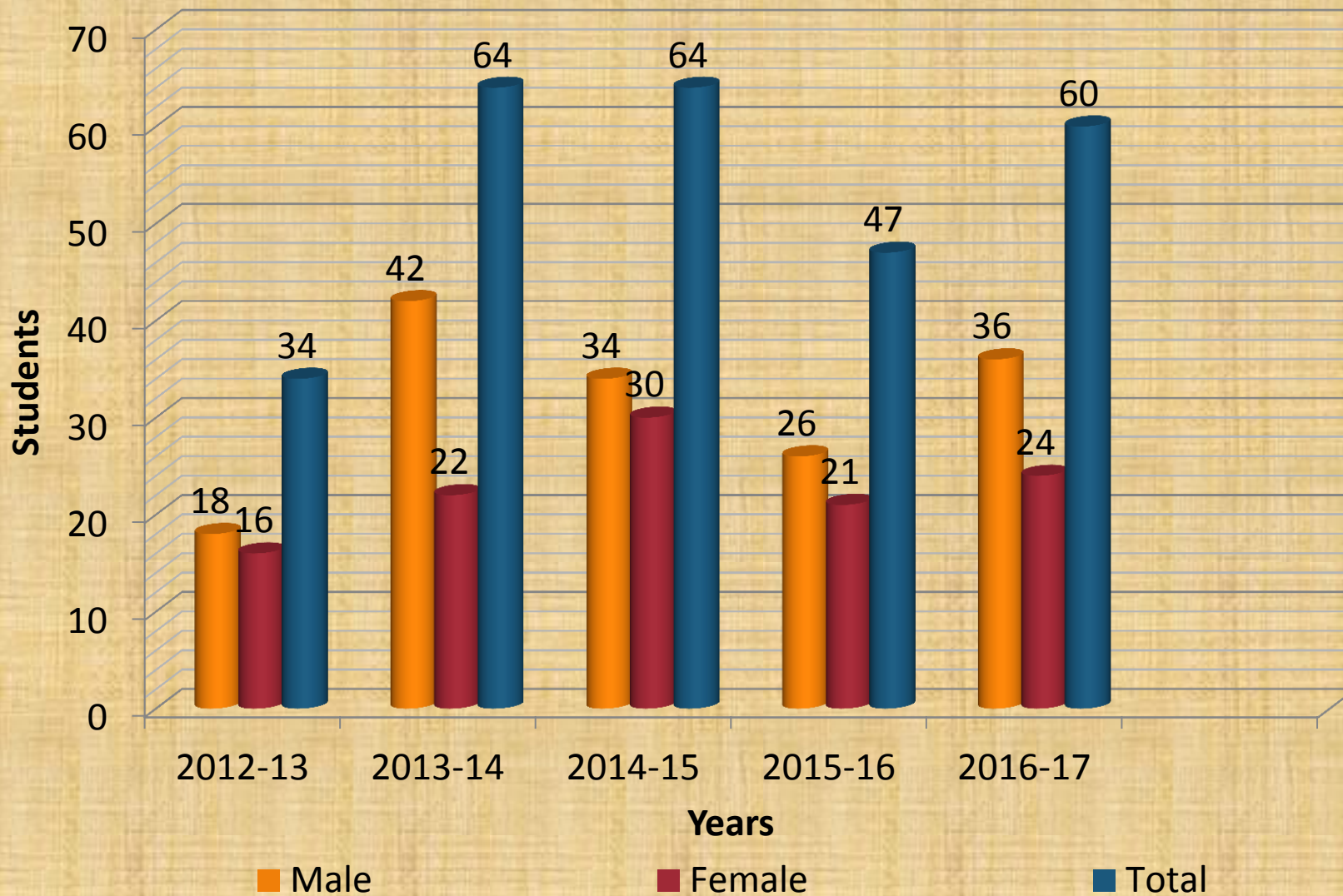

STUDENT STRENGTH GENDER WISE: GRAPH



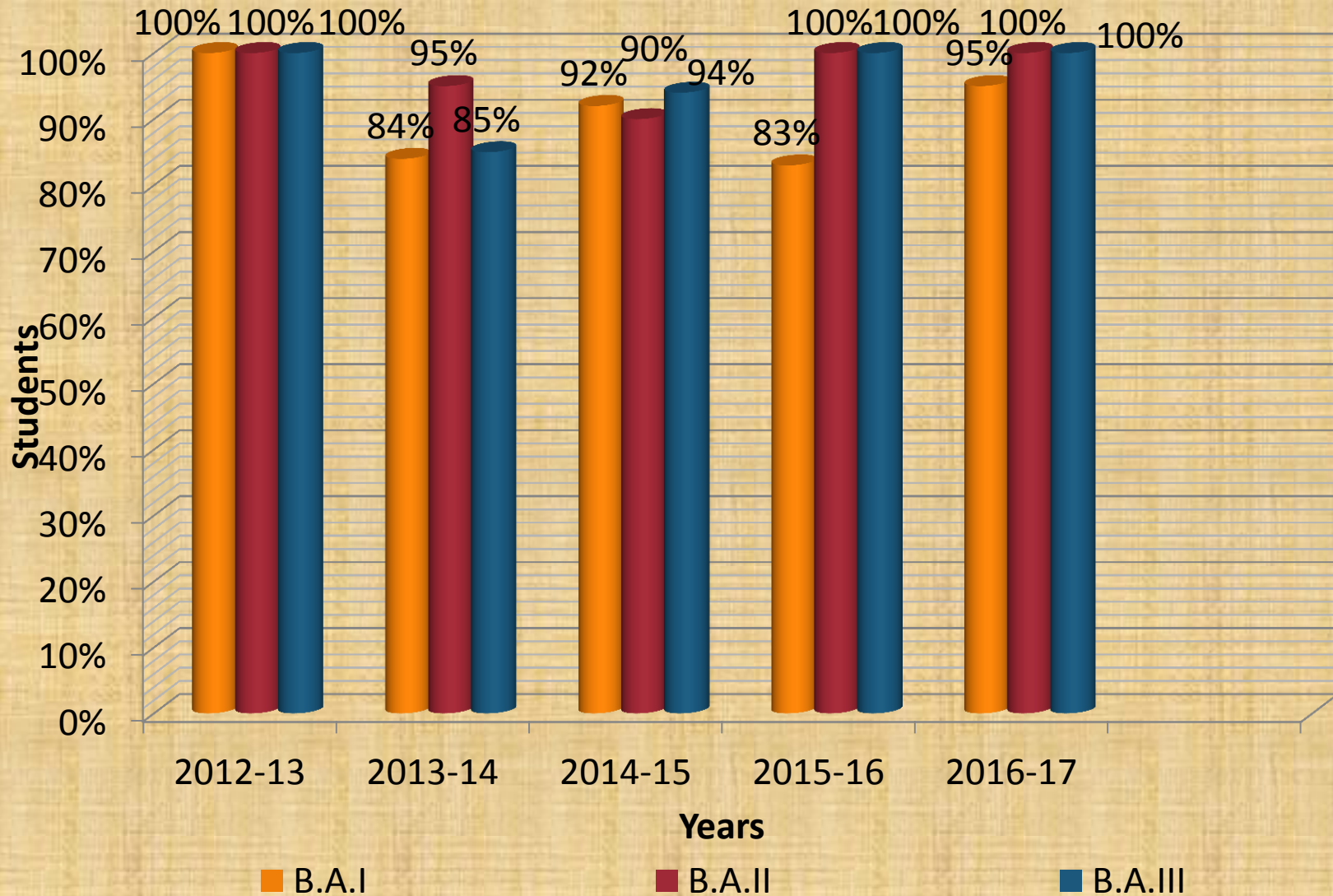
